Arkansas Corn and Sorghum Acreage**

Table 1 presents USDA Farm Service Agency's 2013 certified Arkansas corn planted acreage by NASS district. In 2013, corn was planted on 862,866 acres in the state. The leading two districts were District 6 and District 9, with 304,546 and 270,337 total acres planted, respectively. These two districts are located in the Delta region of Arkansas, and represented approximately 67% of corn planted acreage in 2013. Average irrigated acreage for District 6 and District 9 were 98% and 99%, respectively.

Table 2 presents USDA Farm Service Agency’s 2013 certified Arkansas sorghum planted acreage by NASS district. In 2013, sorghum was planted on 121,852 acres in the state. The leading two districts were District 6 and District 3, with 80,607 and 26,266 total acres planted, respectively. These two districts are located in the Delta region of Arkansas, and represented approximately 88% of sorghum planted acreage in 2012. Average irrigated acreage for District 3 and District 6 were 58% and 49%, respectively.




Figure 1 presents planted corn acreage categories for Arkansas counties in 2013.




Figure 2 presents the top five counties in corn planted acreage in Arkansas. Phillips and Desha counties led the state in corn acreage planted, with 65,394 and 65,141 acres planted, respectively. Arkansas, Chicot, and Jefferson Counties complete the top five counties in corn acreage planted. These five counties represented approximately 35% of total corn acreage planted in 2013.




Figure 3 presents corn irrigated acreage percentages for Arkansas counties in 2013.




Figure 4 presents planted sorghum acreage categories for Arkansas counties in 2013.




Figure 5 presents the top five counties in sorghum planted acreage. Phillips and St. Francis counties led the state in sorghum acreage planted, with 11,365 and 8,828 acres planted, respectively. Monroe, Lee, and Cross Counties complete the top five counties in acreage planted, and represented nearly 60% of sorghum planted acreage in 2013.




Figure 6 presents sorghum irrigated acreage percentages for Arkansas counties in 2013.


