Table 1 presents USDA Farm Service Agency’s 2013 certified Arkansas rice planted acreage by NASS district. In 2013, rice was planted on 1.06 million acres in the state. The leading two districts are District 3 and District 6, with 498,105 and 427,204 total acres planted, respectively. These two districts are located in the Delta region, and represented nearly 88% of planted acreage in 2013.




Figure 1 presents planted acreage categories for Arkansas counties.




Figure 2 presents the top five Arkansas counties for rice planted acreage. Poinsett and Lawrence counties led the state in rice acreage planted, with 86,445 and 83,775 acres planted, respectively. The counties of Arkansas, Lonoke, and Jackson complete the top five counties in acreage planted. These five counties represented approximately 36% of total rice acreage planted in 2013.


